A Stewardship Reflection

Sometimes in my daydreams I imagine myself as an author, with the title of my best-selling book being, *Searching For Nazianz: A Journey to Belong*.

To give of my time, my talent (okay, not sure I have any!) and my treasure, is my way of life, and you my brothers and sisters, my family. For years and years, I longed to be part of a spiritual family where Christ is the center of our coming and going, a place where mercy and forgiveness run in haste to meet the call to repentance, the hallmark of true and holy family life.

The give and take of a parish family is necessary for the Holy Spirit to strengthen the gifts we receive. In this family, in this place, we foster a Christ-like love for one another and the world. Sometimes, our brothers and sisters agree with us and together, we move forward and yet other times there is tension, as differing opinions emerge. But in the end, we are family. We might "give" a bit more or "take" a bit less so that all are nourished and our faith community grows stronger and ultimately healthier.

Stewardship...an interesting word. Simply put, it is recognizing that everything we have and everything we are is a gift from God and being grateful and generous with those gifts. I like to think of it as if we are stewards on a ship. The duty of a steward is to serve the ship and carry out the orders and instructions of the ship's captain. The Captain of this ship is Jesus. As your sister in Christ, I will pick up my oar and row with you, side by side, night and day, through thick and thin, through calm seas and rough waters. I will row well... with all my mind, with all my heart, and with all my strength. I was adrift for so long as I searched for Nazianz. Like the Gospel story, after searching the waters, here among you, I discovered a pearl of great price, and like you, I will give up everything to keep it close in the treasury of my heart and soul.

Thoughts for Today's Readings



To the Point: Jesus' cryptic dialogue with Pilate does not make much clear. One thing that is clear though—that has been clear throughout Jesus' teachings—is that his idea of kingship is very different from ours. His idea of power is different from ours. It does not look like what we expect. He carries on this very dialogue from a position of vulnerability, where he is held captive and his life threatened by those with worldly power. We who are baptized into Jesus' missions as priest, prophet, and king are called to challenge the notion of kingship that clings to power and sees some humans as more dignified and deserving than others. We have the ongoing challenges of wrapping our minds around a leadership that really does operate from a place of humility.

To Experience: In baptism we are anointed to share Jesus' office as king. As such, we are called to enact service and justice to others. Each of our relationships presents an opportunity to live Jesus' mind-bending leadership based not on power but on self-gift. Relationships where we hold some sort of power or authority are all the more an opportunity to hold that power in a way that serves those it affects.

1. What work do you have to do to make this world a place that can more readily accept Jesus as king? What work does your own heart need to do the same?
2. In what relationships do you hold some sort of power or authority? How can you bring Jesus' power, rooted in self-gift, into those relationships?
3. The psalm proclaims Jesus' unfettered glory and majesty, which are often not obvious in the way earthly power is exercised. Where do you see God's power on display in your life?
