MEETING MINUTES

April 13, 2021

- Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm by Chair Matt Schneider, he led the group in prayer.
- Approval of March 9th, 2021 meeting minutes
After review of the March 9th minutes, a motion was made by Mary, second by Karen to approve the minutes.
- Finance Report
Pam reported on the March finances: total receipts - \$9,626.62; Expenses - \$8,393.83; net - \$1,232.79.
- Christian Women Report
Lois noted that their last meeting was Sunday, April 11th. They plan to donate \$100 to the Crossing in Manitowoc for Mother's Day. They are having the Bake sale May 2nd. They are planning to clean up the rectory: April 23rd pressure washing outside, May 18th cleaning inside.
- Liturgy Committee Report

- Building & Maintenance Committee Report
The Perch Fry resulted in a profit of \$21,428.26. They have updated two fryers with new valves and Dennis Graf is fixing up the third fryer which will be put up for sale when ready.
The control box for the Carillon Bells needs to be replaced; the cost of a new control box is \$3,720.
A meeting with the Cemetery Committee resulted in a plan to have a concrete pad poured on the south side of the storage garage.
Clean-up of the church grounds is scheduled for April 19th.
- Religious Education Report
A written report from Patti Wilhelm was reviewed by the council.
- Cemetery Report

- Athletic Club Report
Matt noted that at their last meeting, they are looking into doing a Casino night as a fundraiser event. They also discussed bringing back the other events which were cancelled last year. It appears they will have five baseball teams to sponsor this year.

- Public Input
Dennis A. mentioned that the Parish sign in front of the rectory is falling apart and should be replaced. The sign is outdated and doesn't stand out for people to see. He is in the process of talking to RLO Sign Company about costs to replace the old sign.

- Old Business
The church windows from Oconto were packaged and are in storage at the shop by Kevin Binversie. Dennis A. noted that one window was apparently damaged when it was removed from the frame of the old church. Abler Art Glass has been asked to provide an estimate to repair the window. A discussion followed as to notifying Holy Trinity Parish of Oconto about the damage from the removal process and that we should not have to pay to have the repairs made. Randy noted he would work up a letter to be sent to Oconto Holy Trinity asking them to reimburse us to repair the damaged window.

- New Business
Regarding the terms of Trustee and Parish Council members, Pam was asked if she would renew her treasure position if no one stepped up to take it. Matt indicated that he is not running for another term for Parish Council and that position will need to be filled.

- Suggestion Box
A comment in the box asked where all the COVID signage was. Barb noted that it was condensed on one signage board instead of the two boards that were there. A response will be addressed in the bulletin.
