Christian Women: Lois reported- Hosting bake sale May 1, launching an “Adopt-a-Flower Pot Program”, the request for helpers with funerals, etc. had a good response- Thank you. Supplying muffins for June 12th.

Liturgy Committee: The six Altar candle holders are there. Veils for Tabernacle are completed and in use.

Building & Maintenance: \$20,257.15 profit from this year’s Perch Fry. Newmann Plumbing isn’t supplying an estimate but will do work on North, West & East faucets for \$112/hour plus material- Faucets leak and are hard to turn. Skipping the heater project for the new, back room, will use small heater for now. New weather stripping in front entrance \$122.00. Waiting on shed quote from Kraus & Meyer. Konz electric for inside lighting on the windows and cross in Bell Tower. The handrails for the front of Church are at the painter. Purchased vacuum cleaner \$159, range hood for Father’s kitchen \$129, and a fridge w/ top freezer for \$849 for total of \$1,1037. Rebates went to new cabinet shelving. Erv Koenig and Dennis donated the wood.
