MEETING MINUTES

March 9, 2021

- Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm by Chair Matt Schneider, he led the group in prayer.
- Approval of February 9th, 2021 meeting minutes
After review of the February 9th minutes, Dennis noted that only one freezer was purchased, the other appliance was a cooler. A motion was made to approve the revised minutes with the noted changes and seconded.
- Finance Report
Pam reported on the February finances: total receipts - \$8,369.70; Expenses - \$10,244.10; net loss - \$1,874.40.
- Christian Women Report
Lois reported that 1,886 calendars were sold for a profit of \$9,081. They donated \$150 to the Crossing in Manitowoc and \$150 to the CP drive. Their next meeting is April 11th.
- Liturgy Committee Report

- Building & Maintenance Committee Report
Dennis noted that the cost to have the furnaces checked over was \$680.
Dennis noted a donation of \$150 was received from Cindy Wipperman.
The Perch Fry resulted in 1,394 plates being sold; along with the raffle, profited over \$21,000.
He also noted that issues with the fish suppliers resulted in a lesser quality of fish being offered; he asked the Finance Committee if they could retain \$5,000 to purchase the fish in advance, which they did approve.
Dennis noted that they are planning to run 220v power to the storage closet in the meeting room in order to place the newly purchased freezer in that area. Mike Mueller, a parish member, is working on it.
- Religious Education Report
A written report was reviewed by the council.
- Cemetery Report
A new Cemetery regulation sign is being made and will be installed when completed.
- Athletic Club Report
Matt noted that as a Parish Council member, he will be attending the Athletic Club meetings

through June. After that, a new PC member will need to be appointed.

- Public Input
Lois was wondering if any discussion has been considered regarding providing a back-up for Barb in case she is gone for any length of time. Barb noted she is working on a folder which describes her duties and when they need to be completed.

- Old Business
The window committee meeting of March 4th had 18 people present. They chose 5 of the 8 windows to be installed and photos would be displayed in the hall for people to review and comment on.
Two people volunteered to assist with documenting the script sales; training will begin.

- New Business
A \$50 Kwik Trip gift card will be sent to Fr. John in appreciation for his assisting with Masses.
After review of the Deacon chair being provided through a donation, Jandrain Religious Supply will deliver the chair at a cost of \$329.95.
