Christian Women: Dennis reported- donated \$500 to Salvatorian Center in N.H. & \$200 to CP telethon. Next meeting, April 3.

Liturgy Committee: Wax candles from St. Francis of Assisi not confirmed yet, will order new next week. Veil for Tabernacle may be here for Easter. Blood of Christ, by Intinction, was brought up to Bishop and the answer was “not at this time”- other Parishes have also requested. Looking to discontinue “social distancing” in church- but will do so after Father announces at Mass & asks for concerns to be mentioned or put in suggestion box. Also plan to announce we’ve unlocked the back doors to Church. We do still want a “head count” of people at Mass.

Building & Maintenance: Neumann Plumbing Heat & AC quoted \$3,00 – \$7,000 for heat in the new, back room. On faucet estimate- still can’t find source of faucet. We have some damaged siding that will need to be replaced. Handrail installation/design is in process.

Cemetery Committee: No Report.

Public Input: Image of Mary, Our Lady of Perpetual Help, with candle burning, is in support & prayer for Ukraine. Located near the Nave. Ruth brought up a concern of stability, with the open flame. Looking into securing the candle.

Old Business: Perch Fry served 598 plates at noon. Total of 1,206 plates sold. Catholic Financial Life gave \$500 in support of PF. Committee members Diane Bonde & the Valukas’ are stepping down. Mary Beth Hickman took over for Diane, as treasurer. Still looking for others. Mike Herzog was give \$80 in SCRIP for donating the oil. The Tempo ran our ad for \$220 vs the typical \$440. The perch fry food got great reviews.

New Business: Observance of Mothers Day & Fathers Day will include something special for the Mothers & Fathers. Memorial Day to be observed with 8:00 am Mass at our Cemetery Alter. Discussion on whether we want to hand out a gift similar to Christmas, this Easter. Not this year. Little Books- refer to budget for Parish to pay for books and ask parishioners for free will offering. Increase copies available to 40 per season. Father is looking at trialing a Flocknote subscription. Looking to update the Legacy List, in our bulletin- tabled to April meeting. Discussion as to what to do with books that where left from Christmas; some will be kept in the office (as a gift for new members), someone would like a few for a book study, and the rest would be distributed to area "Little Libraries". One by One campaign to be starting up again.
