Christian Women: Lois reported- Green chasuble was bought for Father @ \$614.19. Planning a “Fun Day” with lunch for children in the Parish on a Saturday morning. Currently in planning /idea stage.

Liturgy Committee: Memorial Day Mass will be held at 8:00am, May 29th, in the cemetery, weather permitting.

Building & Maintenance: Perch Fry sold 1,368 plates and brought in \$25,000+, *prior* to payment of all expenses. Next perch fry meeting is scheduled for April 23rd. Gutters scheduled to go on new shed next week. Doug Schneider, of Total Plumbing, will quote septic repairs. The third classroom is used for storage. For safety reasons, it will be locked when not in use. A back-up janitor is needed- Al will be on vacation Friday – the 26th. A plan for janitorial duties should be considered. Main responsibilities, while filling in, would be to clean bathrooms, empty garbage cans, maintain candles.

Religious Education: First Communion retreat was held last Saturday. March 29th, RE students & Family event. RCIA scrutinies continue with the finale at the Easter Vigil. Report provided by Patty Wilhelm.

Cemetery Committee: No Report

Entrust Retreat; dates are available and Council members are encouraged to attend. There’s been positive feedback on the program. Attendance is free of charge through the Bishop’s Appeal.
