### Revised MEETING MINUTES

May 11, 2021

- Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm by Chair Matt Schneider, he led the group in prayer.
- Approval of April 13th, 2021 meeting minutes  
After review of the April 13<sup>th</sup> minutes, a motion was made by Karen, second by Mary to approve the minutes.
- Finance Report  
Pam reported on the April finances: total receipts - \$16,772.52; Expenses - \$10,466.90; net income without Capital Improvements - \$6,305.62. Capitol Improvement for the purchase of the control box for the Carillon Bells cost ~~\$2,585.62~~ \$3,720.00; net income with Capital Improvements \$2,585.62.
- Christian Women Report  
Lois noted they set dates and paid for Masses for Veterans Day and Christian Women for 2022. The bake sale made \$474. They plan on donating money to the Salvation Missions in New Holstein. At their last meeting, they had election of officers: President – Carol Heinzen; Vice President – Lois Albright; Secretary – Mary Valukus; Treasure – Pat Steffen. The next meeting is scheduled for September 12<sup>th</sup>.
- Liturgy Committee Report  
Matt noted that the new control box for the Carillon Bells has been installed and is operational with some fine tuning needed on the settings for the music portion.
- Building & Maintenance Committee Report  
Dennis noted that he is waiting for estimates on replacing the gutters on the rectory. They are looking into installing railing on the steps at the alter with the concern as to where they should be installed without being in the way of Mass activities. Dennis received a quote from Buddy Kienbaum for pouring a concrete pad next to the storage shed for \$8,548. Dennis noted that the septic system backed up and had B & M Pumpers look into the problem. They were able to relieve the problem but noted that down the road something will need to be done to improve the overall system.
- Religious Education Report

- Cemetery Report  
They are looking into replacing the walk behind weed trimmer due to its age.

- Athletic Club Report  
Matt noted that they scheduled a Casino night fundraiser at Meats on April 2, 2022. They had a 55 gallon gas storage container installed by Country Visions Coop in one of the storage sheds for their mowers and weed control equipment. There will be six teams playing baseball at the diamonds this year.
- Public Input  
With the easing of COVID-19 restrictions, collection offering was discussed with ushers using handled baskets instead of the drop boxes at the church entrances. It was decided to continue using the drop boxes through June or until it's ok to use the hand baskets again.
- Old Business  
A letter written by Randy directed to Holy Trinity Parish in Oconto addressing the damage to the stain glass windows was reviewed. Matt proposed that the issue be run past Fr. Klingeisen, the acting parish Administrator, to have him determine what should be done.
- New Business  
Sharon Mueller approached the parish requesting the use of the portable message sign for the Kiel Garden Club plant sale on June 5<sup>th</sup>. It was decided to charge a \$25 rental fee.
