Christian Women: Hosting November coffee & donuts, Bake Sale Dec. 5th with 1/2 proceeds going to support *The Crossing* in Manitowoc. Hosting Christmas Party Dec. 7th in Hall; 4:30 social with 5:00 supper. Next meeting Feb 6.

Liturgy Committee: Advent & Christmas seasons discussed, Missalettes return in pews, Daily Mass will change to 8:00am beginning Jan 2022 with Mass times moving to Monday - Thursday. Signage on intersection X&A and in front of Church will need to be updated. Decorate for Christmas Dec 22. Father may be interested in additional Advent/Christmas programs next year.

Building & Maintenance: The Bell Tower will be done this week w/Cross up Saturday. Extra bricks are in the garage. No estimate received on the shed or plumbing. More topsoil was added by Scott Lawn Services. \$750 to update Father's House. Camera wiring is in & the entire lot is covered. Addition of 8th camera to monitor the back entrance. Working on Perch Fry; the fish type ordered is a 2-3 oz Pike Perch fillet. Aluminum cans were taken in for a profit of \$495.

Religious Education: Written report provided by Mrs. Wilhelm

School Hill Athletic Club/Men's Club: Looking for a new cooler. Next meeting Jan. 19th. Father plans to attend meetings, but still suggests a liaison- no interested party has volunteered.

Cemetery Committee: Discussed investments in last meeting. One gravesite headstone is tipping- family was contacted and it will be taken care of in Spring. Father was wondering if there was an alter behind Church & briefly discussed possibility of having a Spring/Memorial Day Mass there.

Public Input: A plaque was suggested to replace paper signage under stain glass windows. Plaque to list Saint's Name, Feast Day, Patron of, Birth & Death date- potentially prayer cards available with it.

Old Business: No liaison for SHAC was found. One by One campaign has a June/July "re-engage" scheduled; currently, our One by One campaign funded the stained glass windows. The \$10,000 grant we received for Youth Ministry is still available & we will look into options/ideas. Father mentioned *March for Life/Pilgrimage for Life* in D.C. for 7th grade & up. It's an energizing event for Youth. Look into post card mailing, possibly Christmas- if not, Lent/Easter season. List Mass times & intro to Father Brunner. Planning on stations Fridays @ 5:00 with different groups leading (possibly).

New Business: Communion remains as Host, and no Cup. We will return to passing collection baskets. "Life is Messy" book has been ordered for distribution to all interested people. Pam & Lois volunteered to take Christmas Gifts to parishioners who reside in facilities. Father Bill has been named Priest-Moderator for St. Peter & Paul, St. Anna, & Holy Rosary till June 30th. Pizza & Movie Night is starting up again. Working on Parish Capital Improvement Projects procedures, updates are still needed. Randy is Point on procedures. Motion brought & approved to update *Voting Needs* to reflect a Roll call vote vs use of Ballot votes and voting to be done in-person; no absentee voting. More work to be done on procedures.
