Perch Fry: February 18th. Committee: one couple is out and one individual has joined. There will be no silent auction, but we will have the Raffle again this year. Tortes/Desserts will be offered for sale this year. Perch is not readily available and the committee has looked into different options. They sampled 6 types of fish and were most interested in the "Crispy Pike Perch" variety. Keeping "Perch" on the menu is important- crowd favorite and also allows us to keep the same signage.

Suggestion Box (annual meeting follow-up): *Bell volume:* we were uncertain which bells the suggestion referred to. *Goals from Parish Mission Planning:* where are we with it? *Restroom Signage:* needs to be more visible, it was suggested to brighten the color of the current signs. *Visits to Homebound:* in general- are we, and how are we handling it? Currently 2 volunteers are assisting in this area, and the Christian Women continue to be active in this ministry.
